Call to Order and announce a Quorum is Present

3A. Review and approve minutes from regular meeting on January 18, 2018

3B. Receive an update and take any necessary action on bleachers and other equipment from the Rockdale ISD stadium for parks

Tim Ramey suggested coordination with boys baseball and girls softball fields for aluminum bleachers to replace wooden bleachers.

- Pool to open Memorial Day weekend

- Donated pavilion going up this month
- Lights for bridges when Verizon signs their contract for the water tower
- Calaboose will go in once we get estimates
