To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to notify you of upcoming construction work on Rice Street which will consist of the construction of a new water line. The project limits for this section of the work start in the south at the intersection of Rice Street at its intersection with East Cameron Ave, and include all of Rice Street up to the northern project limits at the intersection of East Ferguson Ave and Smith Road.

The project will begin on approximately Tuesday, November 6, 2018.

Work activities to be performed which may affect your use and access to the roadway will generally include trenching along the west side of Rice Street. Work crews may also be operating equipment on the street to transport materials. Other impacts to the public may include noise and dust from construction activities.

Driveway access disruptions may occur as a result of the construction work. In instances where the work affecting access to a driveway is not completed within a single work day, temporary access will be restored to the driveway through the provision of a temporary driving surface.

Roadway access limitations to a smaller width of the roadway surface should be expected, however, the work area in progress will be delineated with traffic control measures. After completion of construction and testing of the water line, the asphalt pavement and concrete curb will be restored.

Water service may temporarily be affected at certain times within the work period, and work crews will provide additional notice prior to any disruption to water service.

The duration of this construction project is expected to be completed within 120 to 150 days. However, delays in project completion may occur. Your access to your property and the street may be generally affected during the project, however, the period which vehicular access will not be possible to the driveway will be minimized to the extent possible.

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter is to notify you of upcoming construction work on San Gabriel Street which will consist of the reconstruction of the concrete pavement and curb. The project limits for this section of the work start in the south at the intersection of San Gabriel at its intersection with Bell Street, and include all of San Gabriel Street up to the northern project limits just north of the intersection of San Gabriel Street and Thrall Ave.

The project will begin on approximately Tuesday, November 6, 2018.

Work activities to be performed which will affect your use and access to the roadway will generally include the removal and replacement of the concrete roadway. Work crews will also be operating equipment on the street to transport materials and perform the work. Other impacts to the public will include noise and dust from construction activities.

Driveway access disruptions will occur as a result of the construction work. Temporary access will be provided to the driveway through the provision of a temporary driving surface.

Roadway access limitations should be expected, and the accessible portions of the temporary driving surface will be delineated with traffic control measures. After completion of the concrete roadway reconstruction, access to the roadway will be restored.

The duration of this construction project is expected to be completed within 120 to 150 days. However, delays in project completion may occur. Your access to your property and the street will be generally affected during the project, however, the period which vehicular access will not be possible to your driveway will be minimized to the extent possible.

During construction and prior to completion, the portion of San Gabriel Street which is being worked on will be limited to local traffic only, and will be closed to thru traffic. Trash services will be coordinated with the contractor to continue without interruption.
