Consider and take any necessary action on the second reading of an ordinance amending Chapter 3 Building Regulations by adopting the 2018 edition of the International Building Code; adopting the 2018 International Existing Building Code; adopting the 2018 International Residential Code for one- and two-family dwellings; adopting the 2018 International Mechanical Code; adopting the 2018 edition of the International Plumbing Code; adopting the 2017 edition of the National Electrical Code; adopting the 2018 International Fire Code; adopting the 2018 edition of the International Fuel Gas Code; adopting the 2018 International Energy Conservation Code; adopting the 2018 International Property Maintenance Code; providing for permits, fees and inspection; providing for registration and license requirements for plumbing, mechanical, and electrical contractors; providing for a penalty for violation hereof; providing that this ordinance is cumulative of all ordinances; amending the City ordinance and the Code of Ordinances; repealing all parts of ordinances in conflict; providing a severability clause; providing a savings clause; providing severability, penalty, emergency and open meetings clauses; and providing for related matters**
