With a quorum of the Council members present, the Regular Meeting of the Rockdale City Council was called to order by Mayor Boren at 5:30 p.m., September 19, 2022, at City Hall, 505 W. Cameron Ave, Rockdale, Texas

5A. Consider and take any necessary action on the first reading of an ordinance for the levying of an Ad Valorem tax upon the real, personal, and mixed properties in the City of Rockdale, Texas for the year 2022, an occupation tax equal to one half the state levy, and split payment option for payment.

MOTION BY RECORD VOTE: Upon a motion made by Councilmember Perry and a second by Councilmember Walker, the Council voted four (4) for and none (0) opposed to approve the first reading of the ordinance as presented, adopting the City of Rockdale 2022-23 ad valorem tax rate of \$0.84 per \$100 assessed valuation, the debt service portion being \$0.208193 per \$100 assessed valuation and the maintenance and operations portion being \$0.631807 per \$100 assessed valuation. Motion carried.

At 5:36 p.m. Council convened into Executive Session pursuant to Texas Government Code Section 551.072 and Section 551.087 to deliberate the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property for the purpose of commercial development inside the District boundaries, and to discuss economic development negotiations related to the same commercial development.


